11. That no payment is released for work graded Unsatisfactory (U) till their grading is improved by the concerned agency in terms of relevant provisions of the contract.

12. That the liquidated damages imposed in terms of relevant clause of conditions of contract (GCC) in respect of the project/ scheme.

- 13. That the payment is restricted to the contracted cost only and will be subject to the condition that no cost overrun of any kind is to be paid.
- 14. That the Bank Guarantees for performance security/advances wherever requiring revalidation are obtained duly revalidated.
- 15. That the recovery on account of statutory deductions/taxes is deposited with the concerned department.
- 16. That the recovery on account of advances is not utilized for payments.
- 17. Deviation if any shall be personal responsibility of the DDO.
- 18. That the above works have been qualitatively checked and found satisfactory.
